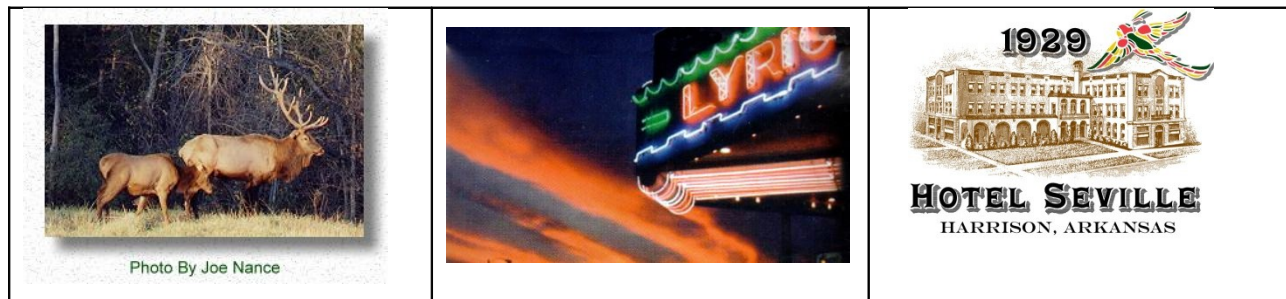


The Gateway to the Buffalo National River

It's a Natural to enjoy the scenic beauty of Arkansas by traveling its most scenic Byway – Highway 7 and landing one night at the 1929 Hotel Seville, enjoying a fine meal and taking in a show at the 1929 Lyric Theater on the downtown square. This Gateway City to the Buffalo National River, Harrison, Arkansas is an ideal stop along the way and provides travelers an opportunity to experience true Americana with wholesome festivals and regular street fairs, a hot air balloon race, several rodeos and regular entertainment.

Sample Itinerary:

- 6 AM Depart Hot Springs, Arkansas
Head to Ponca For a guided viewing of Arkansas' Elk Herd grazing in the pasture by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission
- Noon Arrive in Jasper, Arkansas for an early lunch at the Ozark Café
Shop the Jasper square for unique antiques and trinkets
- 3PM Arrive in Harrison Arkansas to check in at the 1929 Hotel Seville (www.hotelseville.com)
- 5PM Dinner in the Formal Dining Room of the hotel
- 7PM Show at the 1929 Lyric Theater (www.ozarkartscouncil.org)

Following Day

- 8 AM Breakfast at Neighbor's Mill in Harrison
